Chemical	Safe Harbor	Adopted Levels	Date Effective
Antimony Trioxide	No Significant Risk Level	0.13 µg/day (inhalation)	January 1, 2024

Proposed Safe Harbor Levels

Chemical	Safe Harbor	Proposed Level	Date Proposed
Ethylene Oxide	No Significant Risk Levels	0.058 µg/day (inhalation), 1.5 µg/day (oral) [update]	April 7, 2023 (original proposal); December 19, 2023 (modification)

*The existing NSRL for ethylene oxide is 2 µg/day. It was adopted on July 1, 1988.
