


Little Change in Views of Whether the Earth Is Warming



How serious a problem is global warming? (%)







% saying warming caused by human activity % saying global warming is a very serious problem



Highest Belief in Global Warming Most Concerned Most Motivated




In your opinion, do you think global warming is...; Do you think global warming is a major or minor...



About One in Ten Americans Understands That More Than 90% of Climate Scientists Have Concluded Human-Caused Global Warming Is Happening





Only Four in Ten Americans Hear About Global Warming in the Media At Least Once a Month; Fewer Hear About It From People They Know







How often do you discuss global warming with your family and friends?

Most Americans Think Global Warming Is a Relatively Distant Threat




How much do you think global warming will harm...? Base: Americans 18+ (n=1,263). March, 2015.
