**NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF THE DATA CALL-IN PERIOD FOR THE REQUEST
FOR RELEVANT INFORMATION ON THE CARCINOGENICITY OF
VINYL ACETATE**

A request for relevant information on the carcinogenicity of vinyl acetate was announced by the California Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Environmental Health Hazard Assessment (OEHHA) on July 7, 2023. The notice initiated a 45-day data call-in period that was scheduled to close on August 21, 2023.

At the request of the Vinyl Acetate Council, OEHHA hereby extends the data call-in period. The data call-in period will now close on **Monday, September 18, 2023**. OEHHA strongly recommends that submissions be made electronically, rather than in paper form, through our website at <https://oehha.ca.gov/comments>.
